

# January 23rd-25th, 2026, The Bield at Blackruthven, Perthshire Cost: £295 per person, includes two nights accommodation, all meals and the use of all Bield facilities

"Come with me, by yourselves, to a quiet place and get some rest." (Mark 6:31)

This facilitated retreat weekend is an opportunity to respond to Jesus' invitation, to pause in the busyness of life. Sometimes we need to slow down before we can consider "being" rather than "doing", to sense what we might be invited into in the year to come. The weekend will feature times of guided reflection exploring **rest**, **becoming** and **walking more closely** with the One who invites us.

The weekend will be hosted and facilitated by Susan Mansfield. Susan is an experienced retreat leader and spiritual director trained in the Ignatian tradition who has been running retreats, Quiet Days and reflective walks in Edinburgh since 2010. She trained in contemplative spirituality and spiritual direction with the Epiphany Group and Ignatian Spirituality Centre, Glasgow. The spirituality of St Ignatius is at the heart of what she offers, but she also draws on a number of other contemplative and creative traditions. #### The Weekend

We'll start at 4pm on Friday 23rd January (The Bield asks us to arrive by 3.30pm if possible, but we can accommodate anyone who needs to arrive later) and finish at 3.30pm on Sunday 25th. The weekend will include a mixture of input, personal and guided reflection and plenty of space and time to rest and enjoy the grounds and facilities at the Bield.

### Costs

The total cost for the weekend is £295 per person, which includes all the facilitation, printed material, two nights accommodation, meals and the use of all Bield facilities. There is a deposit of £50 which is payable at time of booking to secure your place.

The deadline for bookings is Friday 21st November 2025. The balance must be paid by that date.

Cancellation policy: Deposits are refundable up until 21st November. If you cancel after that date, you can only be refunded if your place on the retreat is filled. This is due to The Bield's cancellation policies.

#### Venue

The Bield is a Christian retreat centre set in parkland near the village of Tibbermore on the outskirts of Perth. It is accessible by taxi from Perth railway station. As well as beautiful grounds, gardens and a woodland area to walk in, it has two labyrinths (one accessible for wheelchair users), a well-stocked art room and a heated swimming pool.
